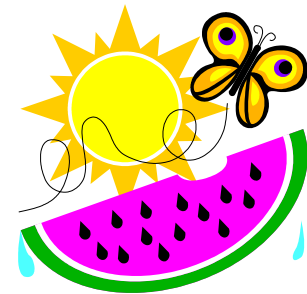

SFC Virginia is a foster-based animal rescue group in Fredericksburg, VA. Founded in June 2019 with a focus on saving dogs and cats from high-kill shelters in the state, we strive to provide quality medical care including vaccinations and spay/neuter surgeries, and to find permanent adoptive homes in our area. Our goal is to make a positive contribution to No-Kill Virginia 2020 and No-Kill Nation 2025.

We are a ground zero level rescue with the mission of saving animals from High kill shelters throughout the state and getting those animals in need into permanent adoptive homes. We do not have a facility to house these animals in, we are foster based only. We are setting up to do adoption events at local businesses and events in the area. Our core area of focus for adoptions is Fredericksburg and Stafford.



Things we are in need of are: (in new or good used condition) animal crates/carriers, child/pet gates, play pens, dog toys, dog food, cat food, cat litter, potty training pads, kitten and puppy formula, kitchen scales to weigh our fosters, digital thermometers, animal food bowls, flea and tick medicine, towels. Some animals are in need of Medical Attention this is where donations work wonders!
Any of these items can be brought to Lees Hill Golf Club. They will notify us and we will pick up.

But most importantly we want to get these animals adopted. So spreading the word about us, visiting our webpage, facebook or Instagram and Sharing! Signing up to foster through our webpage or Adopting a new best friend are also great ways to help these animals.

Turf Talk

Above average temperatures and heat indexes exceeding 110 degrees descended on us toward the end of the month. This stretch of hot weather hasn't been experienced in our area in several years. Thanks again for your patience, as we continue to water greens throughout the day in order to lower canopy temperatures and preserve our turf. Cool season turf stress is common on putting greens during the summer months due to the excessive temperatures and high humidity in our area. A solid agronomic plan, which includes cooling the greens during hot summer afternoons is imperative for turf survival.

Typical summer maintenance continues this month, including bunker edging, tree trimming along cart paths to provide adequate vehicle clearance, edging yardage markers and irrigation heads and adding sod to bare areas on tees and fairways. Another course wide fertilization is scheduled for later this summer to provide nitrogen for continued growth and potassium to carry us through the rest of the year.

Stay hydrated, and we look forward to seeing you often during the remainder of the summer golf season.
