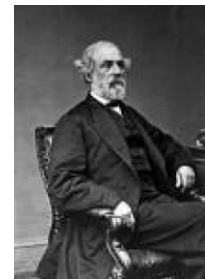

Turf Talk July 2020

The dog days of summer have arrived. The heat is on with a record number of consecutive 90 degree days. As of this writing, we stand at 23 and counting , with little relief in sight. It has also been extremely dry, with no recorded rainfall in over three weeks in our area. We have been conserving our water for the past several weeks to ensure that we have a sufficient supply for our cool season putting greens. We will continue to cool putting surfaces in the afternoon until the hot weather has abated.

On the course we have leveled and repaired the brick stairs on holes 12, 13 and 14. Landscape plants have been installed near the putting green and in various locations around the course. Thank you for adhering to the 90 degree cart rule. This is even more important during periods of hot, dry weather.

Also, please continue to fill divots with sand and repair one extra ball mark when on the green. Stay cool! Looking forward to seeing you on the course.
