Our Ladies League plays in Virginia Southern Match League with 7 other teams. July 26 was our last match of the year and was played at Lee's Hill.

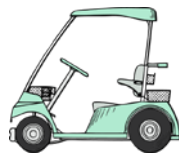

TURF TALK

Fortunately August was not as hot and dry as it is most years. The greens that suffered in July improved some, but most importantly they did not get worse.

We will be aerating greens on August 29th and 30th.

Amendments, organic fertilizer, and sand will be brushed into the holes before seeding, rolling and watering. Most greens should be fully healed in two to three weeks while the weaker greens getting seeded may take a little more time. We then can begin verticutting and lowering the height of cut to produce a much quicker and smoother surface.

The bermudagrass on fairways, tees, and rough is extremely healthy. It has been difficult keeping up with its mowing, but we will take that problem versus a drought anytime. Excessive growth has caused some accumulation of grass clippings at times, but we are doing our best to blow and remove them as fast as possible.

As the Summer comes to an end the maintenance team will be working to get the course ready for our Club Championship and Member/Guest Tournaments. Along with getting our greens back in great condition we will be seeding collars and the driving range tees with perennial ryegrass. This will give us green turf in those areas through the winter when bermudagrass goes dormant.
