September & October

We would like to encourage you to review the enclosed calendar, review the on line calendar and become familiar with the events that are taking place in the busiest part of the season, September & October. As we move into these months, not only are golf outings taking place but groups from all parts of the country are coming to our wonderful area. If the date and time you want to play is not available, we encourage you to contact us directly. We would be glad to contact one of our neighboring golf courses and do our best to see what they have available for you. We are monitoring the tee sheet very closely and free up tee times as the information becomes available to us.



TURF TALK

Extremely dry and hot weather has dominated our area since June. To date, we have received a scant 6 inches of rainfall and have had 56 days of temperatures above 90 degrees. Rainfall is approximately half of typical, and temperatures have averaged about 5 degrees above normal. Judicious greens watering has been key to maintaining our turf this season. Although dry, our fairways and tees consist mostly of bermudagrass which is drought tolerant.

To ensure that they transition to fall weather with adequate soil moisture, we will begin providing additional water with the assistance of wetting agents. These compounds help to break soil tension and ensure that the moisture penetrates the root zone. In the meantime, we have been spraying weeds in the rough and surrounds to cleanup any stragglers left over from the spring. Bunkers have been freshly edged and we are in the process of edging yardage markers and irrigation heads .

Enjoy the rest of the summer, stay cool and we look forward to seeing you on the course.
