TURF TALK

Turf Talk August 2020

Tropical storm Isaias took care of our drought issue this summer by dumping 4 inches of rainfall on the course. Combined with the runoff from the neighborhood, the irrigation lake on hole #10 was filled overnight! It was amazing to see a five foot increase in the water level within a 24 hour period. This beneficial rainfall also greened the course up significantly.

Sufficient soil moisture is very important as we move into the fall. Proper hydration prior to turf dormancy, allows the plant to better cope with the stresses of winter weather. Projects on the course continue. Recently additional sand has been added to bunkers, a truckload of rock has been installed at the front of the clubhouse and additional areas on the course have been roped off to help facilitate growth in heavy traffic areas.

As we move into the cooler weather this fall, we look forward to seeing you often on the course!
