This year for Member Guest we welcome our Members to bring another member as their guest.

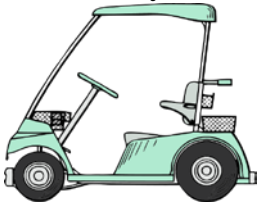
