### **Turf Talk**

As we move into fall, our weather has remained warmer and wetter than normal. Winter kill areas continue to fill in with new turf throughout the course. We have applied extra fertilizer and additional sprigs to these areas to facilitate recovery by the end of the growing season. Our plan is to sod any areas remaining before cold temperatures preclude Bermuda grass growth for the year.

Growth regulator use is continuing on greens,tees and fairways to promote lateral shoot growth and enhance turf density. Weed spraying remains a priority as we continue to eradicate goose and crabgrass and have recently targeted nutsedge in the greens collars. All collars will be overseeded this fall after the edges have been treated effectively.

Greens aerification in early September helped to relieve soil compaction, promote root growth and improve nutrient uptake. Thin and bare areas on putting surfaces have also been seeded with Authority bentgrass to help promote faster turf recovery. This type of bentgrass is known for quick establishment and superior lateral growth qualities as documented in recent NTEP trials.(National Turf Evaluation Program, conducted by the USDA.)

Greens will continue to be treated for optimal recovery for the remainder of the season through a balanced fertility program and continued topdressings to promote recovery into bare areas. Bunker and yardage marker trimming are underway, probably for the final time this season as warm season turf growth begins to decrease. We hope to see you soon as we are set to enjoy some great fall golf weather!
