Turf Talk

Dry weather has persisted into the late summer with very little recorded rainfall in our area. As of this writing we have received under an inch for the month, a full 2 inches less than normal. The short term forecast calls for more dry weather. We will be watering fairways and tees as needed, not only to provide sufficient moisture for our fall fertilizer application, but also to ease the transition to colder autumn weather.

Please adhere to the 90 degree cart rule to minimize traffic on our dry fairways. Detail work has continued this month with tee plate and yardage marker edging. The greens are healing nicely from our final aerification of the season. We will topdress them again this fall to ensure smoothness and help fill in thin areas. In addition we will apply a potassium based fertilizer to promote turf health, maximize root and shoot density, and ensure that the greens transition successfully to cooler weather.

Thanks again for your patience as we strive to improve the facility. Looking forward to seeing you on the course this fall!
