## **Turf Talk**

Turf Talk September 2020

Cooler fall days have arrived at Lee's Hill, and another tough summer is behind us. Aerification went well last month and the greens are healing nicely. In addition greens 14-17 have been seeded with bentgrass to facilitate quicker recovery and improved turf density.

We have also fertilized the entire course with 19.0.5 plus barricade. This pre emergent application will help us to minimize the bluegrass problem that we experienced last spring while improving overall plant health. Bunker edging is underway, as is edging around irrigation heads and yardage markers. Additional tee boxes have been sodded to fill in bare areas on tees 2,7,11 and 16. Shady areas in the rough, on holes 8,9,13 and 18 have been overseeded with ryegrass to improve turf density.

We look forward to some great fall weather and anticipate seeing you often on the course.
