# <u>Turf Talk</u>

Another summer comes to a close and with it more comfortable fall temperatures. On the course we have been busy readying the turf for the inevitable transition to cooler temperatures. Several applications of soil amendments have been applied to greens to replenish them after another challenging summer. The fairways tees and roughs have been fertilized with a potassium based product to help the bermudagrass better cope with winter stresses by hardening off. Potassium helps to reinforce the plant cell walls resulting in healthier turf.

Please continue to adhere to the posted cart traffic rules and always repair divots and ball marks. Quality course conditions depend on everyone doing their part. Thank You again for your cooperation.
