### **Turf Talk October 17, 2019**

Much needed rainfall finally arrived in mid month. We received 1.7 inches in an 8 hour period. This equaled the entire amount from the previous month! This recent precipitation will help to rehydrate the soil and promote some new turf growth.

Although late in the season for bermudagrass growth, every little bit helps! We rented a diesel pump to transfer water from Lake 12 to our irrigation pond to insure an adequate amount of water for the remainder of the growing season. Total pumpage for a 4 week period was approximately 2 million gallons. Our focus as we move into the fall is to finalize some detail work including; bunker, irrigation head and yardage marker edging.

Fall green and tee fertilization is also a priority to help the turf over winter in optimal condition. Leaf blowing season is upon us as we fine tune our blowers in anticipation. We hope to see you on the course often in the upcoming weeks!
