Turf Talk October 2020

Great fall weather, mixed with intermittent rainfall has been the norm so far this month. We have experienced a beneficial, extended growing season that has helped to improve turf quality throughout the course.

Our fall project list is in full swing. Projects currently underway include; irrigation repairs, brush trimming around ponds and tees, over seeding shady rough areas, fertilizing, topdressing and plugging bare areas on greens and the addition of traffic control in worn and difficult to grow areas on the course. Leaf removal is currently at the top of our list, as our fall color show comes to a close.

We are pleased to announce that Lee's Hill Golf Club has enrolled in the **Audubon Sanctuary Program** for Golf Courses. We will be striving to achieve full certification by completing the entire syllabus in the upcoming months. Audubon International assists courses throughout the country to improve management practices, provide enhanced habitat for wildlife and increase player enjoy ability.

The six areas of focus that must be completed for full certification is; 1 Environmental Planning. 2 Wildlife and Habitat Mgmt. 3 Chemical usage and Safety. 4 Water conservation. 5 Water quality management. 6 Outreach and Education. Upon completion Lee's Hill
