TURF TALK - John Burns, GCS

Cooler weather has worked it's way into our area earlier than normal this year. Our fall seasonal projects are well underway. We have trimmed native areas with the bush hog throughout the course. This winter we plan to cut all woody vegetation around lake banks and teeing areas. This includes lakes on holes 5 and 10 and overgrown tees, particularly on 14 and the Cannon tee on 18. We will also be trimming select trees and vegetation around greens to allow additional sunlight and air movement for improved turf growth. You may have noticed the absence of water cooler stands and trash cans on the course. We are in the process of refurbishing all course and club house fixtures, restoring them to like new condition. Ball washers, yardage and tee markers will also be rebuilt and freshly painted. Irrigation repairs will be made to replace broken piping and replace faulty sprinkler parts in order to reduce the amount of leaks on the course. We will update you on our progress in future columns. I also wanted to thank you for your patience. The course dries out more slowly during the winter months resulting in additional cart path only playing days. We will allow handicapped flags as often as possible and allow cart traffic on the course as soon as we dry out sufficiently. We wish everyone a safe and happy holiday season!
