- Each player must have their own set of clubs, bag and valid green fees receipt.
- Shirt, golf shoes or tennis shoes must be worn at all times.
- It is unlawful to possess or consume alcoholic beverages not purchased from the Greenside Grill, per state law and city ordinance. Personal owned coolers are not allowed.
- Power carts must follow rules posted on windshield. Only licensed drivers may drive carts.
- Pace of play goal is a 4 hour to 4½ hour round. We also define slow play as more than 1½ shots behind the group ahead of you. If you cannot keep pace, we may ask you to pick up your ball and regain your position or cancel your round and refund your greens fee.
- Replace divots, repair ball marks and rake sand bunkers. Multiple shot practice prohibited.
- Out of Bounds is marked by White stakes and course boundary fences.
- Restroom buildings, irrigation boxes and protective netting play as immovable obstructions.

 Water Fountains – Holes 5, 8, 10, 16, & 18
