PGSMC Code Of Conduct

This Code of Conduct establishes clear and acceptable behavioral expectations for all members of Port Gardner Senior Men's Club (PGSMC). It is not intended to restrict the rights of anyone but to ensure that all golfers are treated the same while participating in PGSMC events. Upon payment of PGSMC membership dues, players give their consent to abide by this Code of Conduct.

As a PGSMC member, you are expected to:

- Follow all posted rules and policies of the golf course
- Respect the golf course, golf carts, facilities, staff and other golfers
- Conduct yourself in a sportsmanlike manner, including restraining from profane language, gestures, insults or other such misbehavior
- Abstain from verbally or physically threatening or slandering others, either personally or through social media
- Abide by all state and local laws and regulations
- Report any unusual or inappropriate behavior to the management staff
- Not engage in any form of discrimination or harassment
- Do your part to make golfing at PGSMC events a pleasant experience for everyone by following standard golf course etiquette.

Golfers who violate this Code of Conduct will be asked by PGSMC management to correct their behavior. If golfers continue to disobey the Code of Conduct, the PGSMC board may ban individuals without refund, if applicable.

Golf etiquette reminders

Groups need to keep pace with the group in front of them or finish their round in 4 hours 25 minutes or less.

Each player must have their own set of clubs.

Always return power carts to the path within 20 yards of the greens or tees.

Enter and leave the bunkers from the low side.

Replace divots, repair ball marks and rake bunkers.
