

## 2025 - Lake Padden Sr Men's Tournaments

**1) April 30** – Best Ball - Wednesday Team Event - 2 player best ball member/guest or member/member team. Guests must be at least 55+ years of age and hold a current GHIN handicap. No more than 8 stroke differential between partners. Net and Gross for each team payout. The event will be in two flights, determined by combined team handicap. In this event you will be able to use one ball for both Net and Gross, if necessary and putts are to be holed out.

**2) May 14** - Wednesday – 4 player Scramble. A minimum of 3 drives per player. The scoring will once again be done in 2 flights, determined by combined team handicap. There will be both Net and Gross payouts in each flight. The handicaps will be established by adding all four players' handicaps and divide by 4 for the handicap that will be applied for Net results.

**3) May 28** – Wednesday - Six Shooter. This is a 4-player team event. On the first hole, count the best Net Ball of the four. On the second hole, count the two best Net Balls of the four. On the third hole, count the three best Net Balls for the four. Then repeat this cycle 6 times. All players play their own ball and must hole out to be able to post an individual score. As usual we will have two flights, determined by team handicap. Since this is a net game, we will only pay Net.

**4) June 11** - Wednesday- Coyote Scramble - 4 players. In this format, each player will hit a drive and the team picks one of the drives. Once that drive is chosen the driver of the chosen ball (Called the Coyote) will play the hole alone. The remaining 3 players will play a scramble format through the hole from the same position. . The scoring will be established by adding the Coyote's score to the 3-player scramble score. Each player must be the Coyote at least 3 times. Flights will be established by combined team handicap. Net scoring will be established by adding all 4 handicaps and dividing by 4. The handicap total will be subtracted from the total score to establish a Net score. Once again, Gross scores will be awarded also in each flight.

**5) June 25** - Wednesday – Scramble – 4 players -- Red, White and Blue. Each team will choose any six holes to play from the R/W/B tees. Each of the 4 players must use at least 3 drives. Each team will make their own individual choice on tee

selection. Individual Gross and Net payouts for both flights. There will be two flights determined by group handicap.

**6) July 9** – Wednesday - Three Ring Circus. 2-player event. Each team will play the first 6 holes in Chapman Alternate Shot Format. Each player drives and you play each other's drive for the second shot and continue to alternate from there until one ball is holed. The second 6 holes will be the best ball format (Gross Scoring). The last 6 holes will be a 2-player scramble with no minimum drives. Teams are only allowed a 10 handicap stroke differential. Handicaps will be added together and divided by 2 to establish a team handicap for net results. There will be two flights determined by team handicap.

**7) July 23** – Wednesday - Lone Ranger. 4 player teams. On each hole, one member of the team is designated as the Lone Ranger and plays the hole solo. The other three team members play the hole as a scramble. Scoring is the sum of the Lone Ranger's score and the scramble score of the remaining 3 team members. Each member must be the Lone Ranger at least 4 times

**8) August 6** – Wednesday – Me Too. Two man best ball with a twist. Each player may ditch his ball and move his ball to the location of his partner's ball (called a "Me Too". There is a maximum of six "Mee Too's" per player with a Handicap differential of 8.

**9) August 20/22-** Club Championship (Individual Event) This is a 36- hole Wednesday and Friday Tournament from the black tees.

**10) September 3** – Wednesday – 3 Clubs and A Putter – Individual Stroke play from the black tees. Individual stroke play with two flights. Play Gross and Net. This will be a shotgun start so to finish play for the annual LPSMC Meeting following play.
