HANDICAP CHAIR REPORT:

Score Posting will start on March 1, 2026

Scores must be posted on your personal devices either thru, wagolf.org, www.GHIN.com or the USGA /GHIN app on your phone.

Once again, a Point of emphasis is posting scores as soon as possible. Handicaps will update at midnight daily for posted scores.

As a reminder, the handicap committee reserves the right to adjust handicaps in Men's Club events to protect the integrity of the game. The past few seasons the Board has received complaints of players not posting or posting incorrect scores to manipulate handicaps. *The handicap system is in place to create fair play amongst different levels of golfers in our tournament and leagues. Please Post all scores high or low to keep your handicap correct.

-Post all 9-hole scores. 9-hole scores posted adjust your handicap the next day. No more waiting for a second 9 Hole score to combine them for an 18-hole adjustment.

-For the warmer weather down South guys. Shorter Par 3 / Par 4 Executive Courses are now eligible for Course/Slope ratings, so be aware that scores should be posted when played.

Just a few reminders for the World Handicap System-

-Handicaps are based on your best 8 scores of the last 20, your handicap now changes the next day after posting a score.

- Max score per hole for posting purposes - is a Net Double Bogey, which is par +2 strokes, plus any Handicap strokes allowed for that hole.

Tournaments - The handicap policy for our Lake Padden Men's Club Tournaments has not changed. Players will receive a "boxed score" for any net score of 68 or lower in tournament play. Two boxed scores in a rolling 12-month period will result in a handicap

modification in accordance with the policy. If you are boxed, it only applies to Men's Club Events. You will be notified by email with a letter suitable for framing.

USGA RULES REPORT:

Welcome to the 2026 season of play at Lake Padden. We will play our tournaments, as we always do, under the rules of the USGA. This year we are adding "Model local rule I-1.2" to the "Notice to Players" for Twilight League. This allows practice on the competition course before the competition round. Now players can play the day of Twilight League without fear of disqualification.

I would like to remind everyone, especially our new members, that the local rules on the back of the scorecards are not meant for us. You will receive an email that will outline the "Notice to Players" for each tournament. Please pay attention to these as they change from time to time depending on course conditions.
