Construction is Going Well at Canyon Lakes

Construction is going well. As many have noticed with the removal of the putting course and area behind the old cart barn. We are getting ready to demolish the old cart barn and start construction on the new cart barn which will be in the basement of the new Golf Universe and Canyon Lakes Golf Shop. Management is excited to see the progress and is hopeful that all the construction will not hamper the availability to the course and practice areas. Reminder that change is always hard, but the end result will be worth the short time of pain with regards to dust, dirt and inconvenience. Soon we will be able to release digital

renderings of the buildings and the entire project. Thank you to Craig, Chris and Scott for making the best course event better with these new facilities. Everything has started with the clearing of the area that will become an expanded parking lot and taking the existing place of the first 4 or 5 holes of the putting course and the two small ponds by the cart barn. The large lake that reaches out to Canyon Lakes Drive remains untouched. The area will go through demolition and then after all the construction is done, becomes more parking that we need for both tournaments and Golf Universe.

Phase 1 will be the demolition of the ground to prepare for a holding lot for all the equipment that is needed for the construction.

Phase 2 will be the excavation of the cart barn which will be a basement underneath the new Golf Universe and Canyon Lakes Golf Shop. After the cart area is done, they will put the cap on and start the new building to hold Golf Universe and Canyon Lakes Golf Shop.

Phase 3 will be the demolition of the Duck Pond building. The Champion's room will not be touched and will be opened up to the new Pub/Grill that which will replace the

current Duck Pond. This new building will have a number of upgrades to the deck and building. Canyon Lakes will get the dining experience it has long deserved. So many great changes and in a relatively short period of time. We will have both bathrooms operational along with food and lounge access during the entire time. So no interruptions or portable bathrooms! If you have questions, please come ask in the Golf Shop. We are very excited to get this project started and finished. Please pardon our dust while we give everyone the best place in the Northwest to play golf, dine and socialize.

From the Maintenance Crew

We have switched back to the Red, White and Blue flags. They will continue to stay in the rotation. McCurley Dealerships have provided the flags as part of their sponsorship with all the events.

Please stay on all cart paths where they are provided. Please keep all four tires on the cart path. Please make sure to replace divots or sand them. Also please help with ball marks as much as possible.

To ensure the best results,

it is important to keep golf carts away from approach areas to greens. For those that have Blue flagged carts, no cart should ever go between a green and a bunker, or between the green and lake on number 9. This will be strictly enforced and understand we need to be consistent with everyone. It might be a few more feet away, but laziness really causes a lot of damage. If everyone does their part, we will see a difference. With most groups going out with

Golf Now Has Become Our New Online Provider for Tee Times

Our online tee times are now available to be booked through Golf Now. This will have several advantages for both the customer and the players using the website. It will ask for a credit card for everyone. Members will not be charged for any times made unless they become a no-show issue. All other players will be charged through the website to make it easier as you check in. This new system will allow players to book all their times online. Members must sign up through the portal on the main page of the website. You will have had to have registered when you signed up with an email address, that when you attempt to log in on the new members portal will identify you as a member so you are not paying green fees when you sign up. Collecting 2025 Memberships

We are now offering the Prime Season Pass at this time, it is a better value to pay for everything at one time, but monthly is still available.

The six month passes will be from May 1 to October 31. We have named them the Prime Season Pass because you are using the prime months and not having to pay for the other months. The only restriction is that once you have signed up, you will need to continue the payments until the membership runs out. This means that if you sign up in June you will have to still pay for May if you're doing the monthly plan. There will be no prorating or stopping if you sign up for the monthly plans.

to cancel any times that they know they won't be using. Summer is a great time of year and we should have lots of times to book. Even with the 9AM to 12PM reserved times for public play, we still have availability 3 days out for members to book those unused times.
