## Construction Continues at Canyon Lakes

The construction project continues into July, and is going well. As of this writing the new cart barn has been at least dug out. We are days away from pouring the footings and foundation for the cart shed. Feel free to take a look, but please be very careful to not get too close that you put yourself in danger. We will continue to use the new path around the pine tree close to the putting green to access both the putting green and driving range. Coming in the first couple of weeks in July we will have to close the breezeway to the 10th tee. As an alternate route, we will use the path back to one, and cross the 18th fairway to access the alternate tees next to the lake at the bottom of the 10th hole. This will only be needed for a couple of days at most. We appreciate your patience while the new project progresses forward.



We might have to close the range for a day as we will have no access to it. But we will make every effort to not close anything down for more than a day. You may have noticed that the new ownership is also taking care of some trees that needed either trimming or removal.

KID has agreed to service the Canyon Lakes irrigation system that previously was the Canyon Lakes Water Company. This includes all homeowners that live North or below the canal, and a few that live above or South of the canal.

them for any issues regarding lines, pressure or emergency shut off. They have been fantastic to work with from our end and will be a better fit going forward for all homeowners. When they have completed revamping the system to have water

## Golf Now — Our Online Provider for Tee Times

You can book tee times online through Golf Now. This has several advantages for both the customer and the players using the website.

It will ask for a credit card for everyone. Members will not be charged for any times made unless there is a no-show issue. All other players will be charged through the website to make it easier as you check in.

This new system allows players to book their times online. Members must sign up through the portal on the main page of the website. You will have to register when you sign up with an email address, so when you attempt to log in on the new members portal it will identify you as a member so you are not paying green fees when you sign up.
