2025 memberships are still available. Monthly passes will have no joining fees and will be collected on the *first of every month*. This started in January. At this time, monthly memberships will have to pay the prior months, January, February and March, in order to qualify for the monthly

plan. Presently, it is a better value to pay yearly.

The six month passes will run May 1 to October 31. We have named this the *Prime* Season Pass because you are using the prime months and don't have to pay for the other months.

The Full Season Pass will be now through December 31. This pass is for the entire year.

Both of these passes can be paid monthly. The only restriction is that once you have signed up, the payments continue until that membership runs out. There will not be prorating or cancelation if you sign up for the monthly plans.

Members will have the ability

to reserve tee times 10 day in advance for all other tee times Monday through Thursday and on Friday, Saturday and Sunday not between 9AM and 12PM.
All this has taken effect.

As of March 28, 2025 we have opened the member portal from Golf Now so that members will be able to book tee times. Instruction can be found on our website.

From the Maintenance Crew

We have decided to go back to the Red, White and Blue flags for the remainder of 2025. After a lot of input we have listened and decided to make the change back to our prior flags. We hope everyone likes the change back to the original flags.

We have listened and decided to make the change back to the prior flags.

Please stay on all cart paths where they are provided and on all cart paths this time of year. Please keep all four tires on the cart path.

Please make sure to replace divots or sand them. Also please help with ball marks as much as possible and stay out of frost covered areas with carts at all times.

To ensure the best results it is important to keep golf carts away from approach areas to greens. Blue flagged carts, no cart should ever go between a green and a bunker, or between the green

and lake on number 9. This will be strictly enforced and understand we need to be consistent with everyone. It might be a few more feet away, but laziness really causes a lot of damage. If everyone does their part, we will see a difference. With most groups going out with member play in four carts it creates a lot of wear on turf during a time it is not growing. The Golf Shop will be talking to those that violate cart usage rules. If you have questions, please see Matt Mandell in the Golf Shop.

As for the canal work, they are finishing the work on holes 14 – 16 at this time. The last stretch from five tee to six tee will be done when the KID can finish it. We are hoping that will happen next winter. KID will lets us know when they plan on returning to finish the lining for the canal.
