2025 Memberships Now Available

2025 Memberships:

Monthly passes will have no joining fees and will be collected on the first of every month starting this January.

For those that are current members paying monthly, you will have 2 payments coming up this next month. Your 2024 payment will be on January 10th and your 2025 starting payment will be due on the 1st or when you sign up for 2025 membership.

The biggest change to memberships are that you have to sign up for either a twelve month pass or a six month pass. The six month pass will be from May 1 to October 31. We have named that the Prime Season Pass because you are using the prime months and not having to pay for the other months.

The Full Season Pass will be from January 1 to December 31, 2025. This pass is for the entire year.



Both of these passes can be paid monthly. The only restriction is that once you have signed up, you will need to continue the payments until the membership runs out. There will be no prorating or stopping if you sign up for the monthly plans.

All yearly passes will see a significant savings for paving the entire pass at one time. See us in the Golf Shop to answer any questions.

From the Maintenance Crew

The maintenance crew has started the two cup policy until spring. They will have two cups cut into the greens so that we may move pins periodically when we have frost and at times frozen conditions. When the ground freezes it is impossible to move hole locations. Pins will not be moved as much during the regular season due to frozen conditions and not as many players. Reminder to players playing, if the capped cup location interferes with your line of putt, you get the nearest point of relief and not nearer the hole to move your ball. This is only when your ball is on the putting green. Chipping does not get relief. Ball must be on the green.

Please stay on all cart paths where they are provided and on all cart paths this time of year. Please keep all four tires on the cart path. Please make sure to replace divots or sand them. Also please help with ball marks as much as possible and stay out of frost covered areas with carts at all times. To ensure the best results it is important to keep golf carts away from approach areas to greens. Blue flagged carts, no cart should ever go between a green and a bunker, or between the green and lake on number 9. This will be strictly enforced and understand we need to be consistent with everyone. It might be a few more feet away, but laziness really causes a lot of damage. If everyone does their part, we will see a difference. With most groups going out with member play in four carts it creates a lot of wear on turf during a time it is not growing.

The Golf Shop will be talking to those that violate cart usage rules. If you have questions, please see Matt Mandell in the Golf Shop. As for the canal work needing to be completed, we will find out more after the canal is emptied and the KID lets us know more information.
