We are asking members to approve an increase in the annual capital expense. Voting yes will not increase your dues. The annual limit to the capital dues is \$300 and was established in our bylaws back in the 1970's. For years now we have not been able to correctly reflect the capital expenses members pay on their statement as the annual capital dues have been maxed out. We are asking you to vote yes and allow your statements and our accounting to reflect the actual amount of capital dues we pay. Once again, voting yes will not increase your monthly dues.

This requires a member vote because it is an amendment to a current bylaw. In person and virtual Q&A session dates are listed below. 
A change was made to a CP USTA policy


