Q How old does my child need to be to participate in Junior Golf?

A We work with juniors' ages 5-17 years old.

Q Does my child need equipment or anything special to participate in junior golf?

A No. All clubs and golf balls are provided at no charge. If your child has clubs they may bring them - we will ensure they are the right size for them.

Q Does my child need any golf experience?

A No. We provide lots of experience! Juniors from beginner level to those with experience may participate. Each junior will learn in a group based on their experience.

Q What is the focus of Junior Golf?

A We focus on teaching children how to play golf in a safe and fun environment. We have developed a program that is fun filled, has lots of innovative ideas and games to teach your child both the game of golf and life skills such as sportsmanship, judgment, perseverance, and seven other essential keys to becoming a better person. We encourage them to set goals for themselves and assist them with achieving those goals.

Q How do I sign my child up for Junior Golf?

A Registration for the Introductory Clinics is at Douglas County Parks and Recreation Dept Call 782-5500. Registration for the 6 Week Program is at Carson Valley Golf Course - see web site www.carsonvalleygolf.com or other flyer for dates or call 265-3181.

Q What is the Junior Golf refund policy?

A No refunds are given once your child has been guaranteed a spot in a clinic. We realize that occasionally special circumstances arise and we deal with each situation on a case-by-case basis.

Q Do you accept children with special needs?

A Yes. Please call 265-3181. We will do our best to accommodate your child.

Q What is the cost and how often does my child attend?

A The cost for the 6 Week Spring clinic is \$130 (cost is \$110 for sibling participants). Your child will participate in a clinic once a week. The cost for the Introductory Clinic is \$20.

Q What is the coach/student ratio?

A Typically the ratio is 1:4 and never more than 8:1
