

Frequently asked questions

1. What is the proper attire at your golf course?

Prairie Highlands requires each golfer to have a collar shirt. Blue jeans are acceptable. No cut-offs please.

2. Does your golf course allow groups of 5?

Prairie Highlands only allows groups of 4 or less unless approved by our Professional Staff.

- **3. What are your hours of operations?** *Prairie Highlands is open for tee times from dawn to dusk.*
- **4.** Do you have a bar or grill at your facility? Prairie Highlands has a full service grill and bar, which includes all the amenities.
- **5. Does your facility have a driving range?** *Prairie Highlands offers a full driving range, chipping area and putting green.*
- 6. Do you have to be a member to play at your course? Prairie Highlands is a public golf course with memberships available.

7. How far in advanced can I make a tee time?

You may make a tee time one week in advance.

8. Do you need to make a tee time?

While walk on play is welcome, making a tee time is recommended in order to minimize any inconvenience in waiting for the tee.

9. What is your tee time or event cancellation policy?

You must cancel your tee time outside of 24 hours or you will be charged the green fees that are booked. Events or outings must be cancelled outside of 30 days or the event/host will be charged for the last number of players submitted for the outing.

10. Are outside or personal golf carts allowed?

Personal golf carts are not allowed at Prairie Highlands. If a golfer chooses to play with a cart, they must use one from PHGC's fleet. Golf cart must be returned in equal condition as when received, immediately following completion of play. Additionally, PHGC will be held harmless for any damages or claims arising from anything sustained while golf cart is rented out.

11. Do you have a twilight rate?

Yes, Prairie Highlands has a twilight rate, but the time moves with the season. This rate is only good for 18 holes and not an unlimited play fee.

12. What is your policy on rain checks?

Rain checks can only be issued on paid 18 hole green fees. If you finish 6 holes, that qualifies as completing 9 holes. If you finish 12 holes, that completes your round. Again, no rain checks will be issued for paid 9 hole fees. All rain checks due to weather are at the discretion of the golf course.
