COURSE INFORMATION

Hermitage Country Club is a 36 hole private club formed in 1900. It is located on the west end of Richmond, about 30 minutes from downtown. The course is situated in a rural area yet services urban clientele. Bentgrass greens, bermudagrass tees, fairways, and roughs summarize the playing surfaces on property. A complete re-grassing was recently finished on the Manakin Course. Cool season turf (save for the greens) was replaced with Latitude36 bermudagrass. The Sabot course is currently undergoing a Bluemuda conversion and a full irrigation system renovation is being planned.

Regardless of the student's previous golf course experience, Hermitage will demand the most possible to secure understanding and an elevated skill set by the internship's end. Overtime will be available as a typical work week is around 45-55 hours.

Intern housing will be provided as well as uniforms, lunch, and golfing privileges.







Duties will involve all aspects of Golf Course Management. Specifically, this will include water management responsibilities, fertilizer and pesticide calibration and application, and all other aspects of turfgrass care including mowing, grooming, verticutting, topdressing, rolling and aerifying. Interns will also be involved in IPM strategies along with crew management and team building. An internship project will be self-created and accomplished during the allotted internship period and at least one week will be spent with the equipment manager team. Interns are required to attend all manager meetings in the morning and will have responsibilities pertaining to happenings on the golf course. This will NOT be an exercise in weedeating and handwatering until 9:00 pm.
