

CHISHOLM TRAIL PARKWAY

Long-term closure of Dirks Road/Altamesa Boulevard begins in early May

Dirks Road/Altamesa Boulevard between Harris Parkway and Granbury Road will be closed to traffic May 4 through summer 2013. Harris Parkway will remain open throughout construction and will allow motorists to access the USMD Hospital at Fort Worth from their driveway off of Harris Parkway. During the closure crews will construct the Dirks Road/Altamesa Boulevard bridges over the Chisholm Trail Parkway main lanes.

Detours:

Eastbound motorists will turn left on Bryant Irvin Road, turn right on Oakmont Boulevard, turn right on Hulen Street, turn right on Granbury Road and then turn left on Dirks Road/Altamesa Boulevard to continue east.

Westbound motorists will turn right on Granbury Road, turn left on Hulen Street, turn left on Oakmont Boulevard, turn left on Bryant Irvin Road and then turn right on Dirks Road/Altamesa Boulevard to continue west.

All closures are subject to weather conditions and will be postponed, if necessary.
