Opioids have become Kitsap County's drugs of choice

Take a moment to really study the photo on page A2, and when you finally need to look away, con-

It happened in the bucobe hamlet of East Liverpool, Ohio, a town of 11,000 nestled along the north bank of the Ohio River. It is best known for its pottery and as the final destination for the body of gangster Pretty Boy Floyd.

The couple in the front seats had, moments before this picture was taken, ODd on heroin. Both have white, bloodless lips. The woman slumps over, eyes open and unseeing, while a police officer reaches in to check for a pulse. There was one, and both survived after being

administered navolone, an over-dose antidote. Otherwise, police said, the two would almost certainly have died.

The East Liverpool police officer who conducted the traffic stop said the driver was trying to tell him that he was transporting his pas senger to the hospital when he lost consciousness.

But the most shocking element is the curly haired little boy in the back seat (face blurred for anonymity). He sits blankly, impassively, betraying no emotion as he stares at the camera from his booster seat. He is just 4, but he has clearly seen this before. The woman is his grandmother.

35TH LEGISLATIVE DISTRICT HOUSE SEATS

Candidates share their views on education, funding issues and other district priorities

As the urban-rural mix of the 26th Legislative District prepares to vote whether to extend the terms of their two state representatives in November, the expansive, mostly rural 35th Legislative District is quietly sorting out two House incumbent-versus-challenger races of its



The 35th district spans territory west of Bremerton and Silverdale, skirting the Port Orchard to the

east and Olympia to the south. It shares portions of Kitsap, Mason and Thurston counties and includes vast sparsely populated areas west of Shelton and into the Olympic National Forest.

While it covers a hodge-podge of disparate communities with their own special interests and challenges. the residents who reside within the 35th District's boundaries are decid

edly rural, fairly conservative and generally Republican.

That is reflective of the district's two House representatives. Dan Griffey, a Republican from Allyn who's the 35th Position 1 incumbent, and Drew MacEwen, who lives in Union, also a Republican incumbent of the Position 2 seat, are reliable.

conservative votes in the state legislature. Griffey was first elected to his seat in 2014. MacEwen is seeking his second term. He was first elected in 2012


