## **2016 Baltimore Stableford Championship Results**

Billy Wingerd used seven birdies to provide much of his scoring and his total of 40 points turned out to be enough to successfully defend a title won last year, when the Baltimore Municipal Golf Corporation held its first Stableford championship at Clifton Park Golf Course. With points for birdies, pars, and bogeys, Wingerd had 21 birdie points, 16 for pars, and three for bogeys.

Jeremy Goodwin finished second with 38 points, followed by Will Zelaya, a former BMGC Match Play champion, 36 points. Brendan McKinney, who lost a playoff to Wingerd last year after the two tied with 41 points, finished fourth with 35 points.

Jim Winner won the Senior title with 37 points, backed by Dale Williams, 35 points.

Wingerd seems to have a comfort zone for the short Harford Road course, which was played at 5,764 yards with a par of 37-34--71. In addition to winning the two Stableford events contested so far, he is a three-time medalist for the BMGC Match play championship which holds its qualifying round at Clifton Park.

First-flight leaders were Eric Hammerbacher, low gross with 32 points, and Ron Brown, low net, 42 points, and Senior leaders were Mike McKenzie, low gross, 36 points, and Joe Smith, low net, 25 points.

The Modified Stableford scoring system lists one point for bogeys, two points for pars, three points for birdies and five points for eagles and 7 points for double-eagles.
