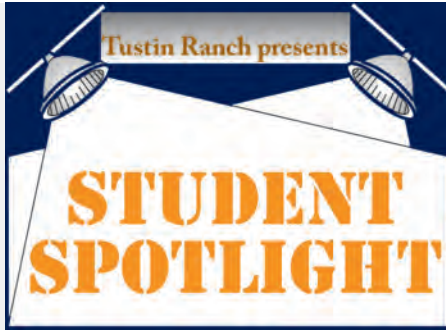

Last year we gave the spotlight to one of Erik Horve's students, Everton Hawkins, and he continues to garner recognition.

After last summer's triumph of being the U.S. Kids Golf 'Player of the Year' he competed at Pinehurst for the U.S. Kids Golf Championship. Following that experience, he was Boys 12 Division Champion at the 2010 U.S. Kids Golf Hawaiian Classic in December at Ka'anapali.

This year, Erik just learned Everton reached the semi-finals of the SCPGA Junior Match Play Championship. He was defeated by a high school senior, after eliminating the No.1 seeded player. The following week Everton qualified for the Junior World Championship, to be held in San Diego later this summer. All his friends at Tustin Ranch wish him the best of luck.

"It's no surprise to me that Everton is flourishing in competitive junior golf. He has an unequalled work ethic and the desire to improve every aspect of his game," states Erik, who has been teaching Everton for over two years.
