9:00 - 10:00 am If the Grass Is Greener On the Other Side, It May Have Been Developed In Tifton, Dr. Brian Schwartz, UGA

The history of bermudagrass breeding at the Coastal Plain Experiment Station spans seven decades. Releases include Tiflawn (1952), Tiffine (1953), Tifgreen 328 (1956), Tifway 419 (1960), Tifdwarf (1965), Tifway II (1981), Tifgreen II (1983), Tifton 10 (1988), TifSport (1995), TifEagle (1997) and TifGrand (2008). TifTuf, released in 2014, has proven to be more drought, nematode, and wear tolerant than most other grasses for many years, and is now available to the public. We will discuss its cultural management requirements, and also herbicides that have been safely applied on it during the past two decades. New trials are also underway to test the performance of new bermudagrass and zoysiagrass hybrids

on golf course putting greens.
