Weekend Players Club Card FAQs

Can I use this card on weekdays?

- The card is valid at any time, however, each round counts as 1 round redeemed, regardless of the day of the week or time of day.

Can I use the card for a 9-hole round?

- Yes, however the 9-hole round counts the same as an 18-hole round.

I redeemed a 9-hole round, but I want to keep playing. Can I do so without redeeming another round? - Yes. However, you may need to wait for an opening when making the turn.

Can I use a round to rent a cart?

- The card is valid for green fees only, and has no cash value. You may purchase a cart rental at the member rate. \$15 for 18-holes, or \$8 for 9-holes.

I have used up my rounds, what can I do next?

- You may play additional rounds at the current rate, or you may convert your Players Club card to a 4-Day or 7-Day membership.

I want to become a member, and I have already purchased this card. Does it count towards my membership dues?

- Yes! You may purchase a 4-Day or 7-Day membership at the standard rate, less \$725. Players Club discount available for prorated membership June through October. Discount does not apply to Twilight/ Afternoon memberships.

Does this card provide access to entry into club tournaments?

- Yes, excluding the Club Championship, Two-Person Club Championship, and the Match Play Championship, but you must keep your USGA handicap here. Sold separately. To be eligible for Members Only events, you must convert your card to a membership before the tournament begins.

I am already a member, can I buy this card for my guests to use?

- Yes, however, cards are assigned individually and are non-transferrable, limited to one card per person, per golf season (4/1/2017-3/31/2018).

I lost my card, but had only redeemed 3 rounds, can I get a replacement card?

- Cards are non-refundable and not replaceable. The University of Maryland Golf Course is not responsible for lost, damaged, or stolen cards. However, replacement situations may be handled on a case-by-case basis, at the discretion of the University of Maryland Golf Course.

Do my rounds expire?

- Yes. You must use all of your rounds by 3/31/2018.
