1. Review of Incident Reports;

Meeting Note: The Committee discussed the recent Incidents within River Strand over the last month. It was reported that there were 32 incidents that ranged from minor incidents to sever incidents. We discussed street lights that were reported to be out which have been reported to FPL.

Meeting Note: The Committee discussed the parking lot lights that are out within the Community. There also appears to be a light pole missing within the Villas section of River Strand. Dan Arens has requested Lennar Land to look into the missing light.

7. New Items

The committee discussed Truscapes vehicles parked in the street as well as in the grass. It has been requested to have them park in areas that will not

affect traffic nor damage grass. An owner discussed individuals that walked through his back yard that were not residents. The Committee advised him to contact the Authorities to have them Trespassed. The entrance to the Sanctuary by Quiet Creek could use some lighting to show the island.
