Golf Tip of the Month

Cobblestone Park is unique to the area in that the topography is more rolling than other venues. Many times during a round of golf you'll find that you have either an uphill or downhill lie. A good rule of thumb is to set up to the ball with your hips and shoulders on the same plane as the slope. (This tends to level out the swing in relation to the slope.) It's also a good habit to generally move the ball slightly back in your stance. Then, make some practice swings to see where the club hits the ground in relation to your stance. That's where you want to play the ball. Make sure you use an extra club (or two) going uphill and you can usually use a little less club going downhill. Practice these shots and lower your scores!

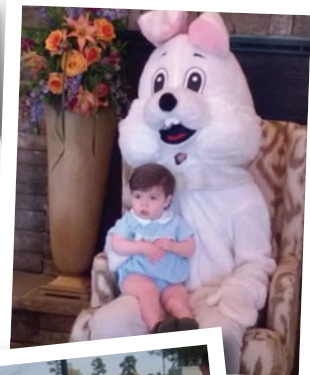
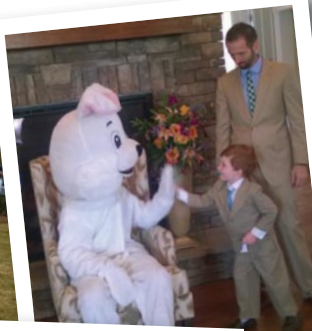
