DIRECTIONS

FROM THE NORTH

I-294 Tollway South to I-55 South (Stevenson Expressway). I-55 South to Route 83/Kingery South exit. Continue South to Route 171 South/Archer Avenue and the club entrance will be on the right at Parker Road.

FROM THE SOUTH

I-355 North to 127th Street exit. Turn right at the light on 127th Street. Follow to Archer Avenue and turn left. Continue 1 mile to Cog Hill. The club entrance will be on the left at Parker Road.

FROM THE EAST

Take I-55 South (Stevenson Expressway) to Route 83/Kingery South exit. Continue South to Route 171 South/Archer Avenue and the club entrance will be on the right at Parker Road.

FROM THE WEST

Take I-355 South to 127th Street exit. Turn left at the light on 127th Street. Follow to Archer Avenue and turn left. Continue 1 mile to Cog Hill. The club entrance will be on the left at Parker Road.

DUBSDREAD #14

Nestled in the Des Plaines River Valley, Cog Hill has been luring golfers to its award-winning facility since 1927. Privately owned by the Jemsek family, Cog Hill is located just 30 miles southwest of Chicago and offers players of every level an opportunity to enjoy the game.

The public golf facility includes four championship golf courses including Dubsdread, which is currently ranked among the **Top 75 Toughest Courses** in the country by **Golf Digest** and **Top 100 Courses** in the country by **GOLF Magazine**. The year-round facility also includes a driving range and learning center, two golf shops, a restaurant with patio seating, along with a 280-seat banquet hall located within the historic clubhouse.

Dubsdread

Nationally ranked since opening in 1964, Course No. 4 has earned its nickname, "Dubsdread." A natural style championship golf course, Dubsdread places a high demand on shot making by providing tight landing areas combined with heavily bunkered, large undulated greens. Average golfers enjoy the beauty and playability of this traditional style golf course, while the best players in the world encounter a challenging but fair test.

In 2008, renowned golf course architect Rees Jones, spearheaded the first renovation project on Dubsdread since it opened. The routing remains the same but every hole underwent renovations from tee to green. Dubsdread continues to receive accolades as being one of the best courses in the country. In 2013, **Golf Digest** named it one of **America's 100 Greatest Public Courses**, the only public course ranked in Illinois. Caddies are available during the summer.

DUBSDREAD #18

Courses 1 & 3

Testing, but not overpowering, best describes Courses 1 and 3. The course layouts are routed through gently rolling and wooden terrain, and consist of elevated and gently sloped greens. The holes offer a nice blend of lengths and difficulty, requiring a range of shot making ability. The courses feature enough sand, woods and water to test the accomplished player without punishing the beginner.

Course 2

Course No. 2 was given the nickname "Ravines." The sporty, championship layout is routed through wooded, rolling terrain and challenges golfers with ravines on nearly half of the holes. Unique to the Ravines course is the closing "19th hole." The challenging par-3 offers a testy putting surface and a memorable end the day's golf match.
