

## Tripp Davis's Renovation Work at Whippoorwill Club Returns Course to Golfweek's Top 100 Classic Courses in U.S. List

**Norman, OK (May 9, 2017)**— The Whippoorwill Club in Armonk, New York, a 1928 Charles Banks original masterpiece, has returned to Golfweek's Top 100 Classic Courses in the USA. Tripp Davis and Associates is responsible for recent renovation work on a course that long has been considered one of the toughest tests of golf in the Northeast.

"We are proud to have been instrumental in helping Whippoorwill return to the Golfweek list at #92," said Davis. "We were brought in to rework all 18 greens and to restore the bunkers and tees in order to return the look and playability of the course to its original style. It was important to recapture the original size and shape of greens, and restore native grass areas that once were predominant on the course."

With clients around the country, Davis and his team are known for their fine historic renovations of classic courses. Other Northeast projects have included New Jersey's Spring Lake Golf Club and Rumson Country Club, Engineers Country Club in Roslyn Harbor, New York, Deepdale Club in Manhasset, New York, Burning Tree in Greenwich and Rolling Hills in Wilton, Connecticut.
