Also, during his time in the military, Chef Louzon served as the senior aide to the vice chief of staff for the Army, conducting dinners for he and his guests including Congressmen, Senators, and Heads of State. For the past 15 years he has held the position of executive chef, overseeing operations at some of the United States largest sports venues including the Washington Nationals Ballpark, Ford Field, and the Palace of Auburn Hills.

- Dining and Lounge minimum - \$250 for each individual
- Priority opportunity to upgrade to a golfing membership in the future
- Not a voting membership
