Indian River Golf Club has a proud history, growing from 1922 when it opened as a private 9 hole course for the Columbus Beach community on Burt Lake. We are proud to be one of the few successful northern Michigan semi-private clubs. Our success is a result of the integrity and quality of our membership. #1 Asset- Our Members

The enduring value of a membership at IRGC is built around the formation of relationships and camaraderie with friends. Friendships are fostered here that can enrich your life style. #2 Asset- Our Clubhouse, Pro Shop and Golf Course

More and more people in northern Michigan are becoming aware of the total golf experience that the Indian River Golf Club has to offer. Our full-service clubhouse features excellent lunch and dinner menus served overlooking the course, on the outside deck or in our spacious grill and dining room areas.

Our full-service Pro Shop, staffed by dedicated, highly- experienced PGA Professionals, offers golf merchandise and an array of golf lessons and clinics for every level of golfer. Our first-class 18-hole golf course measures 6,700 yards from the back tees and has a slope rating of 125. Our outstanding practice facility includes bent grass tee stations, target greens and 300-plus yards of fairway to work on your game. The Club's five different tee areas allows golfers of all caliber to enjoy the beautiful northern woods

setting, natural wildlife, manicured fairways and excellent greens. Well-known for our challenging yet “walkable” layout, Indian River Golf Club has been rated by Golf Digest magazine as “one of Northern Michigan’s best places to play” and has been selected to host the 2012 Michigan Women’s Senior Amateur Championship. Our new elevated tee on hole #3 and redesigned holes #4 and #17 are sure to make the course even more memorable for members and visitors alike.

Indian River Golf Club enjoys special reciprocal golf relationships with a number of courses in both Northern Michigan and Florida. These agreements allow our Club members to play golf at these facilities for generally the cost of a cart.

Additionally, members receive discounts on guest golf fees and golf shop.

It is this focus on continuous course improvement, special amenities, friendly atmosphere and an excellent dining experience, that makes Indian River Golf Club membership the best value in Northern Michigan.

MEMBERSHIP OPTIONS:

- Certificate

- Full privileges to include voting and serving on the Board of Directors and/or authorized committees.
- Stock equity - \$4,200. **(Available from past members for \$800-\$4200.)**
- Initiation fee - \$500 WAIVED.
- Member dues - \$1,415 or Twilight - \$1085
- Spousal dues - \$640
- Family dues - \$175 per child age 19-23, children 18 & under have free green fees.
- Children, children-in-law & grand children play for \$15 or \$25 with cart
- Dining & Lounge minimum - \$250 Single member/\$500 with spouse.
- Applicable fees – cart, locker, handicap, range pass.

- Intermediate

- For members aged 50 and under.
- This is a non-voting membership.
- Member dues - \$710 or Twilight - \$540
- Spousal dues - \$320
- Family dues - \$175 per child age 19-23, children 18 & under have free green fees.
- Children, children-in-law & grand children play for \$15 or \$25 with cart
- Dining & Lounge minimum - \$125 Single member/\$250 with spouse.
- Applicable fees – cart, locker, handicap, range pass.

- Trial

- 1 year trial membership
- An excellent method for prospective certificate members to determine whether IRGC and its many amenities coincide with their personal and social lifestyle.
- This is a non-voting membership.
- Dues and fees apply as per Certificate Member.
- Initiation fee WAIVED.
- No dining minimums
- If a trial member elects not to become a certificate member, all membership privileges become null and void as of December 31.

- Business

- Up to four (4) individuals representing the company may be designated annually by the certificate member
- These individuals have full golfing privileges mentioned above and pay dues and minimums only
- This is a non-voting membership.

- Social

- A membership provided for those not having a golfing interest, but seeking a pleasant and friendly social experience.
- This is a non-voting membership.
- Member dues \$325
- Spousal dues \$140
- Business dues \$500
- Initiation fee \$350 WAIVED.

- Social Business

- A membership provided for businesses not having a golfing interest, but seeking an opportunity to network with the club's members and other business owners in a pleasant and friendly social experience
- This classification allows up to four (4) individuals to join under the business and only pay dues for the business
- Each individual will have a \$250 minimum
- This is a non-voting membership.
- Business Member dues \$500
- Initiation fee \$350 WAIVED.
