

Scholars Competition Sponsored by Jerry Pate Company

The Louisiana-Mississippi Golf Course Superintendents Association is a nonprofit organization committed to advancing environmental and scientific developments in golf course management, providing educational opportunities for superintendents and turfgrass students, preserving the history of the profession and supporting the overall mission of the GCSAA. The goal of the LMGCSA Scholars Competition is to identify and recognize outstanding students who plan careers in golf course management or a related field.

Awards

LMGCSA Scholars receive a scholarship award based on their final ranking in the competition. (Note: Students are NOT required to submit a financial aid statement). Scholarship recipient will be notified by December 10th.

Criteria for Selection

Applications are reviewed by the LMGCSA Scholarship Committee and are evaluated based on the criteria listed below without regard to race, sex, creed, age or national origin. Awards are for one academic year and previous applicants may reapply as long as they still meet all eligibility requirements. The LMGCSA Scholarship Committee evaluates each application on:

- Academic excellence
- Appropriate career preparation
- Potential to make an outstanding professional contributions

Eligibility

To be eligible for the competition, a student must:

- Be an undergraduate student
- Have completed the first year (24 credit hours or equivalent) in a program related to golf course management
- Be currently enrolled in an accredited two, three, four or five-year golf course management or related program
- Seniors graduating prior to the application deadline of December 1st are ineligible.
- Submit the entire application by the deadline of November 1st including: Scholarship Application, Advisor's Report, Superintendent's Report, Official Transcript and Applicants' Essay.

How to apply

Scholarship application forms may be obtained from university turfgrass advisors, the LMGCCSA Scholarship Committee or the LMGCSA office. Students must complete the application form, supply official transcripts from educational institutions attended since high school and provide recommendations from collegiate advisors and superintendents using the forms included with the application. All requested information should be submitted to the LMGCSA under one cover. This application must be completed and received in its entirety to be eligible for consideration by December 1st.
