

## REDS

### *Cabernet Sauvignon, Mount Peak Sentinel, California* \$110

Muscular and intense wine with rich, deep tannins and mouth filling, concentrated fruit, aromas of ripe dark currants mingle with hints of brown sugar and sweet mint.

### *Brancaia IL BCU, Italy* \$90

This wine is intended to demonstrate the elegance, complexity and intensity that Brancaia is now capable of achieving. Many wine lovers around the world already consider it a classic.

### *Red Blend, Abstract by Orin Swift, California* \$65

As soon as a glass is poured, aromatic notes of Luxardo cherries, ripe black plums and raspberries billow, with intricate hints of coffee, mocha and caramel in the background. A blend of Grenache, Syrah and Petite Sirah from acclaimed winemaker Orin Swift. For a limited time only.

### *Rodney Strong Symmetry, California* \$90

Bouquet of blackberries, ripe dark plums, sweet spices and pie crust. Opens boldly on the palate with layers of blackberry, cassis, dark chocolate and brown spice.

### *North Star Merlot, Washington* \$72

Dusty malt, dried herbs and bright cherry flavors are balanced well into this smoothly-structured wine that concludes with a supple, lingering finish.

### *Beringer, Quantum, Red Blend, Napa* 75

Dark cherry, espresso, tobacco, and leather aromas. Notes of ripe plum vanilla, and boysenberry jam are accented with a hint of sage and savory brown spices.

### *Stags Leap Cabernet Artemis* \$85

Aromatically beautiful, alluring notes of dark red fruit and peppery spice.

### *Grimaldi Barolo, Piedmont, Italy* \$80

Excellent, rich wine balancing with zesty red fruit, spice, toasted espresso and finished with textured complexity.

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### *Groth Cabernet* \$95

Dark cherry with aroma notes of plums, dried cherries, and toasted hazelnuts. The mouthfeel is round and juicy with rich fruit flavors of huckleberry and a dried cherry sweetness fade into the warm spicy finish with hints of blackberry.

### *Cakebread Cabernet Sauvignon, California* \$100

Black currant, blackberry, and boysenberry, joined by seductive chocolate and roast coffee scents. Dark berry and cassis flavors balanced by supple, well knit tannins and a long flavorful finish with savory mocha.

### *Chateau St. Jean Cinq Cepages, California* \$110

A Sonoma benchmark since 1990, blended to honor 5 traditional grape varieties, cabernet sauvignon, merlot, cabernet franc, malbec and petit verdot.

### *Silver Oak Cabernet Sauvignon, Napa, California* \$150

Bright aromas of black cherry, dark chocolate, black tea, allspice and ginger. Offering a full-bodied round, balanced mid-palate redolent of cherry preserves, brown sugar and caramel and an extremely long finish of savory ripe fruit.

### *Caymus Cabernet Sauvignon, Napa, California* \$115

The aromatics are layered dark fruits, especially black currant and plums that follow through to the richly textured flavors. Subtle toasted oak supported by firm tannins and excellent acidity. The wine has a long finish.

### *Opus One, California* \$250

Bordeaux-like in its structure and balance, showing cedary oak, dusty berry, dried currant and mineral, with hints of herb and sage. The flavors firm up on the finish, and this is rich and intense without being heavy. The blend consist of Cabernet Sauvignon, Merlot, Petit Verdot, Cabernet Franc and Malbec.
