PRGA crowns 2014 Champions

DAY 4 - Jeronimo J. Esteve IV wins Johnnie Walker Cup / Campos keeps pro division title



Rio Grande, PR - With an eight underpar (-8) score of 280 strokes, amateur golfer Jerónimo J. Esteve IV crowned himself as the overall champion of this year's **PRGA Championship presented by Johnnie Walker**.

Esteve IV finished with a one over par round of 73 strokes towards his overall score after 72 holes play

Jerónimo Esteve earned the first place in the competition, ahead of Robert Calvesbert (284) who came in second place, while 3rd place was awarded to PGA TOUR Latinoamerica player Rafael Campos (285).

Jordan S. Mitchell, (287) who is also an american player active in the latinamerican version of the professional, tour came in second place at the professional division behind Campos after a matching of cards with Luciano Dodda who was the first rounds leader.

Other champions awarded includes Gabriela Santini who repeated as the Champion of the

Ladies Division, as well as Alfred Colón and Felipe Colón who both won the Mid-Amateur and Senior Division respectively for second year in a row. The Super-Senior division champion trophy was presented to Carlos Matos, while Charlie Ronda was the winner of the First Flight who all competed at the International Course over 54 holes and 36 holes respectively.
