Season Membership: Includes discounted access to PRGA Junior Program events, photo ID card, GHIN, National team eligibility, and additional souvenirs.

\$125.00 - Per Player

NOTE: Player's can pay all tournaments in advance; however, they must register for every tournament separately. Meaning that they must fill out and sign the entry form and return it via e-mail, fax or mail.

Regular Season Tournaments: Members of the Program have the opportunity to compete with their peers in monthly tournaments. Membership lasts until the Junior Island Championship. Each tournament & special activity has an additional cost.

Categories 18 & Under, 15 & Under, and 13 & Under Members \$125.00 per event, per player (18 holes each day)

Non-Members \$175.00 per event, per player (18 holes each day)

Categories 11 & Under, and 9 & Under

Members \$100.00 per event per player (9 holes each day)

Non-Members \$150.00 per event per player (9 holes each day)

About the PRGA Jr. Program

The PRGA Junior Program started back in 1970 and gives juniors the opportunity to participate in local golf tournaments, clinics, and rules seminars. Additionally, they are given the opportunity to travel and compete at an international level.

Event procedures:

- Tee times are assigned and posted in the PRGA website the Friday prior to the event at approximately 12:00pm. It is the player's responsibility to know their assigned tee time for each event.
- Tournament/activity information is posted in the PRGA web site www.prga.org and/or sent via e-mail.
- Entry form and payment MUST be received at the PRGA office on or before registration deadline to be eligible for each event. Late entries will not be accepted.
