Valeria's score today was one stroke better than yesterday as she shot an 86, while teammate Natalia Rivera improved from round one by finishing with an 89 today.

The additional 15 points where obtained between a second place by Paola Robles (81) at the Girls 16-17 and also a second place at the Boys 11-13 division.
