Opening Ceremony Officially Inaugurates the Championships

St. Kitts (Aug. 7, 2012) – The 56th RBC Caribbean Amateur Golf Championships officially began on Tuesday evening with a splendid Opening Ceremony at the Marriott St. Kitts Resort, adjacent the Royal St. Kitts Golf Club.

The ceremony, which began with each participating country's players marching behind their nation's flag, brought together the region's best golfers and golf organizers to celebrate the sport. Under the watchful eye of Governor-General Sir Cuthbert Sebastian, who graced the ceremony with his presence and had a front-row seat for the proceedings, the Caribbean Golf Association welcomed one and all to its marquee event.

Outgoing CGA president Asraph Ali remarked on how the tournament represents the best that the game has to offer. "The successes of exciting young players are key for developing the sport and attracting players of all ages and from different walks of life. These championships are a shining example of that," said Ali. "I'm confident that our Championship this year will be exciting, competitive and enjoyable. The golf course is in excellent condition and we have the highest caliber of amateur golfers in the region," he added.

Ali also thanked RBC for its title sponsorship and support of the Birdies for Charity program, which will potentially bring thousands of dollars to each participating nation's designated charitable organization.
