FINAL RESULTS - PRGA Jr. Program Event at Palmas Athletic Club



Humacao, PR (Monday, Oct.3) – The first event of the *PRGA Junior Program 2011-2012* season headed to the east coast this past weekend, as *Palmas Athletic Club* hosted over 60 junior golfers ages 7 to 18 years old. The 2-day event was played at the *Par 71 – Palm Course*.

On **Saturday Oct.1**, the older Boys & Girls categories played their first round, while on **Sunday - Oct.2**, the younger age groups, played the first nine holes of the course, along with their caddies. A good number of new players joined the PRGA Junior Program for the first event of this new season. **Andrew Baez** was the **"best overall score"** in the field and the leader of the **Boys 18&U**, with a total of 142 strokes. During the first round he shot one stroke over par with 72 strokes, while he shot a one-under par **70** on Sunday. The next best score in his category was registered by **Sebastián Toro**, with 145 strokes. **Joito Cardona** earned the first place in the **Boys 15&U** by totaling 146 strokes, while **Felipe Colón**, **Jr**. came in second place behind Cardona, with a difference of 9 strokes at 155. In the **Boys13&U**, **Kenneth Martínez** topped his age group with a steady game and scoring. He shot a total of 153 strokes, while **Ruben Rodríguez** totaled 168 strokes for second place after 36 holes. **The Palm Course**, **designed by legendary professional golfer Gary Player**, **is a very demanding course**.

The Girls Division, of 18&U, 15&U, and 13&U, were won by **Gabriela Santini** (178), **Yudika Rodriguez** (154) and **Valeria S. Pacheco** (162), respectively, the "**Best Overall Score**" was register by Yudika.
