The USGA Course Rating process requires an accurate measurement before we can actually rate the golf course. Measurements from third parties will not be accepted. A PRGA Course Rating Captain will contact you to schedule a day to measure and rate your course. Member Clubs will be rated upon request.

Costs

PRGA Member Clubs that utilize the GHIN Handicap System.

Measurement - \$0 / Rating - \$250 per 9 holes

Non-Affiliated Member Clubs and that use a handicap system other than GHIN.

Measurement - \$150 / Rating - \$500 per 9 holes

TERMS & CONDITIONS FOR SERVICE

Club Responsibilities for the Measurement and Course Rating Days

Measurement Day

- *****Very Important***** Course Set-up – Set tees to their usual position or have course representative to accompany the measurement team to confirm the placement of tees
- Carts – A minimum of 3 carts are needed Marking Supplies – To mark position of the permanent marker for each tee (cans of paint, irrigation flags or a cup cutter)
- Lunch – Each measurement team member shall receive lunch, courtesy of the club
- Golf – The team after measuring shall play a round of golf at your course

Course Rating Day

- Carts – Minimum number of carts would be half the number of raters
- Tee Times – It would be ideal if 2 or 3 tee times were blocked so rating teams can get out ahead of play
- Lunch – Each member of the Course Rating Team shall receive lunch, courtesy of the club
- Golf – The USGA/PRGA requires that the golf course be played to confirm the rating process. It's recommended that this take place on or around the rating date, but in some instances, it could take place on a later date
- Combo Tees – Inform the team of any combo tees the club wishes to be rated

Following the Rating

The data collected by each rating team is forwarded to the PRGA office where it is entered into the USGA Course Rating Software by office staff. A preliminary rating is generated and then sent to both the men and women captains for their approval. When both captains approve these ratings and the Course Rating Committee gives their approval, the ratings are then released to the club and entered into the GHIN system.
