The program will be progressive in nature, in that all of the fundamentals and skills build upon each other to create the golf swing. It is to your child's benefit to be at each session for this reason. The program will cover many areas, such as

G.A.S.P *Grip, Aim, Stance, Posture*

BUILDING A SWING *Hinging the golf club*

TURN AND BURN *How to hit it LONG!*

WHY SO MANY? *What are all of the different clubs used for?*

SHORT GAME *The most important thing to lower your score*

PUTTING *How to become a GREAT putter*

SPECIAL SHOTS *No more fear of sand!*

ETIQUETTE *How to act on the golf course*

RULES *They really are there to help you!*

We ask that students wear proper golf attire (collared shirts, appropriate length shorts or pants, no sandals please). We will plan on having classes each of these days.
