COVID-19 GOLF CLUB UPDATE

On Wednesday, April 2nd, 2020, Governor DeSantis issued Executive Order 2020-91. The EO states that effective April 3 at 12:01 a.m., all persons in Florida shall limit their movements and personal interactions outside of their home to only those necessary to obtain or provide essential services or conduct essential activities until April 30. Per confirmation from the Governor's Office, **Golf is considered an essential recreational activity, as long as proper social distancing is maintained.**

Essential Activities under the EO includes in Section 3 A. ii:

Participating in recreational activities (consistent with social distancing guidelines) **such as** walking, biking, hiking, fishing, hunting, running, or swimming; and...

Accordingly, and as confirmed by the Governor's Office, golf is consider a recreational activity under the clause of "such as" for the purpose of this order.

Please note that it is impractical for the legislature or the Governor's Office to name with exact specificity, every conceivable, acceptable recreational activity that people engage in. Accordingly, they utilized the phrase "such as".

Some counties in Florida have specified that golf courses in their county are closed and **these county orders must be followed.**

When playing or practicing golf during the Coronavirus crisis, players should follow all suggested social distancing guidelines.

Therefore, the Waterlefe Golf Club is open and available for our golf members, residents, and guests to enjoy. As communicated in previous bulletins, the Golf Club is taking every precaution by adhering to the guidelines provided by our Governor, the Department of Health and the CDC. With security measures in place, golfing is a great recreational activity to keep active and enjoy the great outdoors.

The following is in effect at this time:

Golf Clubhouse

- The Golf Club remains open and with doors opened so no physical contact will be needed to enter or exit building.
- Staff will continuously clean and sanitize surfaces.
- A hand sanitization station has been installed for your use as you enter the building.
- Social distancing is mandatory inside the Clubhouse as well as outdoors.

Golf Services

- Each golfer will be provided their own cart.
- Club carts will be sanitized after each use.
- Outside Service Staff has been directed to NOT physically touch golfer's bags or private carts without consent from the owner.
- If you choose to have a staff member help you, they are directed to wash hands and sanitize hands prior to returning to work.
- The golf bag storage has been closed.

Food & Beverage Services

- The Grille Room has set up an outdoor service station and doorstep delivery. The outdoor service station offers daily take-out during the hours of 8 am to 4 pm. Delivery to your doorstep is between the hours of 11 am to 4 pm. Call (941) 744-0393 to order ahead.
- The Grille Room and Lefe Room dining rooms are closed.
- The River Club outside take-out is available for dinner only, Tuesday-Saturday, 4 pm to 9 pm. Call (941) 253-5333 or (941) 744-9881 or email RCDining at WaterlefeFL.com.

Driving Range

- The Driving Range remains open.
- Bag stands and patio chairs have been removed from the range.
- 50% of the driving range mats have been removed to allow for social spacing while warming up. *(continued)*

COVID-19 GOLF CLUB UPDATE *(continued)*

Golf Course

- Golfers are directed NOT to touch the flagsticks.
- A fixture has been placed in each cup to allow for easy removal of your golf ball after holing out.
- Your putt is deemed holed if your ball rests in the cup or if your ball enters the cup and bounces out due to the fixture.
- Encourage "gimmies" if your ball rests within a respectable distance from the hole.
- All rakes are removed from bunkers.
- To the best of your ability, please use the sole of your foot to smooth surface of the bunker after use.
- All ball washers are removed from the golf course.
- All ice and water stations are turned off and disengaged.
- The two comfort stations on the golf course are sanitized regularly throughout the day.
- Tee time intervals increased to 15 minutes to accommodate each player using one cart.
- Weekly sign-ups are now behind the golf cart counter. Please call the Golf Shop to sign up or notify a staff member.

Club Event Cancellations

- All Golf Club events are cancelled through April 30th.

7 Things You Should NOT Do on the Golf Course

While the Golf Club is doing everything possible to keep golfers safe and providing instructions on what to do, here are some straightforward precautions on what you should not do on the course:

1. Don't borrow your buddy's golf clubs.
2. Don't borrow accessories - this goes for towels, tees, ball markers and balls. If they are not yours, don't touch them.
3. Don't toss your partner their ball. Pick up your own ball.
4. Don't toss your partner their ball marker.
5. Don't exchange cash.
6. Biggest rule today - don't shake hands. Instead give a "thumbs up" or a friendly wave.
7. Don't hang around the clubhouse. For the time being, you're at the course for golf or for food carry out. It won't be like this forever but it is for now. Stay safe and play well!
