With the warmer temperatures we have applied a granular fertilizer to the fairways, tees and approaches. The fertilizer is a slow release type and will feed the grass for 100 to 120 days. The fairways are improving, but optimal soil temperatures above 65°F are required for significant growth of rhizomes, roots and stolons. Last week our temperatures were in the low 60's. Looking ahead we will needle tine greens the week of March 4th followed by a verticut and top-dress.

SHARING THE GREEN

The Waterlefe Youth Golf Program (WYGP) is now in its third year of introducing the game of golf to underserved and minority youth in the greater Bradenton area. We have 14 kids Each of our kids now have their own set of US Kids Clubs as well as a golf shirt with our logo on it. We have 2 kids that will be participating in the PGA Junior League this spring!



We are continuing our outreach, a "Taste of Golf" to the various organizations in our area. We have partnered with Big Brothers/Big Sisters of the Sun Coast to find Mentors for the kids in our program. It has been your donations over the last 2 years that has enabled us to launch and continue our program, you are the under-laying foundation that has made it possible for us to begin and build our program. **Thank** you!

We thank, again, the WWGA for collecting over 4,000 golf balls again this year. With Greg Baird's help, we sorted them and sold them to Play-It-Again Sports for \$300.

The WMGA promoted our Super Bowl pool at the Super Bowl Skins game which sold out before the start of the match and brought in \$1000 for our program. We will be collecting "retired golf clubs" the WMGA Master's event in April.



We have received a grant from the USF Federal Credit Union which included us sponsoring the first LPGA Clinic and Demonstration at our course from which we a netted \$6,000 for our program.



Our annual fund raising begins with the "Sharing the Green" on March 10 thru March 18th with the silent auction, a St Patrick's day on the course par 3 challenge and soliciting of personal donations.

This year's "Silent Auction" again includes rounds of golf for 4 at many of the local courses as well as, Golf lesson packages from our professional staff (Steve, Mark, Matt and Grant). Other donations for the auction would be appreciated!
