HE'S DONE IT AGAIN



Dennis Carkonen has wowed us again with his craftsmanship! Last year he launched his first design of driving range targets to be followed up by his largest and best design yet! The raft, christened "Gilligan's Island" by Connie Carkonen, is 12'x12' with a 4'x4' aluminum plate. The raft is situated 85 yards from the mats equaling 100 yards with our flight balls. At least one more target is planned in Mr. Carkonen's portfolio. AERIFICATION UPDATE

It's been an interesting season thus far, but we are using the current events and past struggles to schedule a more aggressive and prescribed approach to our green's cultural practices. We introduced an extra round of core aerification to our greens for this season in early May. We also used that window to test out another aerification machine (called mataway) that was encouraged to us as an aid for aging greens. The machines would allow us to concentrate the work on the upper layer of the profile. We tested that approach on the greens we struggled with this past season: putter, 1, and 2. We were very excited with the results and decided to schedule that machine course-wide in combination with our normal core aerification in late May. The early

May closing went to plan; we were able to core aerify all of the greens, approaches, and tees, as well as slice and verticut the fairways.

The late May aerification closing went very well and we are excited about the recovery response of the turf thus far. Our focus was solely on the greens and we completed both coring and using the mataway machine on all greens. We were able to accomplish two simultaneous aerification techniques in one closing, thus achieving double the organic matter relief from the soil in one round. Our only other goal was spot work on some of the approaches and tees, where different strategies were employed for different stress scenarios. Our next round of closing for aerification work will focus deeper in the greens soil profile in combination with the standard cores.

COVID-19 GOLF CLUB UPDATE

Waterlefe Strong! Now approaching our 4th month since the announcement of a global pandemic, the Waterlefe Golf Club has remained open and available for our golf members, residents, and guests to enjoy. As communicated in previous bulletins, the Golf Club is taking every precaution by adhering to guidelines provided by our Governor, the Department of Health and the CDC. With the following security measures in place, golfing continues to be a great recreational activity to keep active and enjoy the great outdoors.

The following is in effect at this time and until further notice:

Golf Clubhouse

- Staff will continuously clean and sanitize surfaces.
- A hand sanitization station has been installed for your use as you enter the building.
- Social distancing is mandatory inside the clubhouse as well as outdoors.

Golf Services

- Per an update from the PGA North Florida PGA Section, on April 26th, it was confirmed with the Governor's staff that same households may share a golf cart. This is only for individuals who reside in the same residence and includes spouses, significant others and children. All other golfers will continue to be in one golf cart at a time.
- Club Carts will be sanitized after each use.
- Outside Service Staff has been directed to NOT physically touch golfer's bags or private carts without consent from the owner.
- If you choose to have a staff member help you, they are directed to wash hands and sanitize hands prior to returning to work.
- The golf bag storage has been closed.

Food & Beverage Services

- The Grille Room has set up an outdoor service station and doorstep delivery to homeowners within Waterlefe. The outdoor service station offers daily take-out during the hours of 8 am to 4 pm. Delivery to your doorstep is between the hours of 11 am to 4 pm. Call (941) 718-4835 to order ahead.
- The Grille Room and Lefe Room dining rooms in the Golf Club are closed, however, tables and chairs are set up socially distanced outdoors.

Driving Range

- Bag stands and patio chairs have been removed from the range.
- 50% of the driving range mats have been removed to allow for social spacing while warming up.

Golf Course

- Golfers are directed NOT to touch the flagsticks.
- A fixture has been placed in each cup to allow for easy removal of your golf ball after holing out.
- Your putt is deemed holed if your ball rests in the cup or if your ball enters the cup and bounces out due to the fixture.
- Encourage "gimmies" if your ball rests within a respectable distance from the hole.
- All rakes are removed from bunkers.
- To the best of your ability, please use the sole of your foot to smooth surface of the bunker after use.
- All ball washers are removed from the golf course.
- All ice and water stations are turned off and disengaged.
- The two comfort stations on the golf course are sanitized regularly throughout the day.
- Tee time intervals is 12 minutes to accommodate each player using one cart.

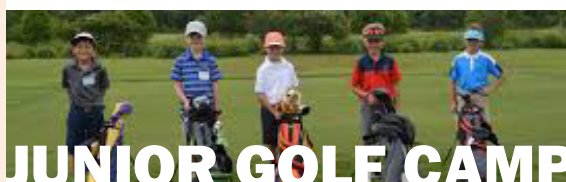
