GOLF CART GUIDELINES

1. Observe the 90 degree rule
2. Obey the green post and exit the fairway to the cart path
3. Keep carts on the cart path around all tees and greens and on all par 3's.
4. Handicap flag carts should keep the cart at least 30 feet from the green as much as possible. avoid slopes and limit travel to the shortest route possible.
5. Scatter cart traffic when entering and exiting the fairway
6. Always buddy up in carts. No single riders unless in a threesome.

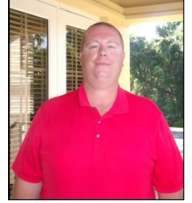

I would like to thank all those who participated in the Women's Invitational and the Men's Member/Member. We enjoy preparing the course for these events and by all accounts, a fun time was had by those that played!

April was another crazy weather month! The course received 7.15" of rain during the month. We also saw a few mornings in the 40's and few afternoons in the mid-80's! The turf doesn't know what to do!

The month of May we will begin the more invasive cultural practices. The first verticut and heavy topdress will be done during the first week of the month and will be done biweekly throughout the summer. Aerification of tee's, fairways, and rough will begin during the week of May 14th. The first of three green's aerifications will take place on May 20th and 21st. Recently we have changed the dates for the other two. The second will take place on July 22nd and 23rd, the third will take place on August 19th and 20th. The turf is recovery slowing after a long/busy season. Aerification, along with continued fertilization, will go a long way in aiding the process...warmer nighttime temperatures would be nice too! During May, we will also make our second pre-emergent herbicide application, our first bulk insecticide application, and will be bulk fertilizing wall to wall! Another busy month at Golf Maintenance! We are gearing up for a successful summer!

Thank you all for participating in the Men's Member – Member tournament in April. Wow what a great tournament. Always during the competition we run into rules situations. The most common here at Grand Haven is where to drop the ball if on a cart path that has brush, trees, palmetto bushes etc, in the direction (nearest point of relief) where the player has to go. This can be difficult at times because the term relief sounds like you are getting a playable situation. Not necessarily true. What you are getting is relief FROM the path not relief for a swing. If the nearest point of relief is in palmetto bushes you have to drop there. There is no guarantee you get an area to swing. You may have to drop to the bushes and take an unplayable from there. Remember, you can always play a stroke from the cart path. You do not have take the relief from the path!

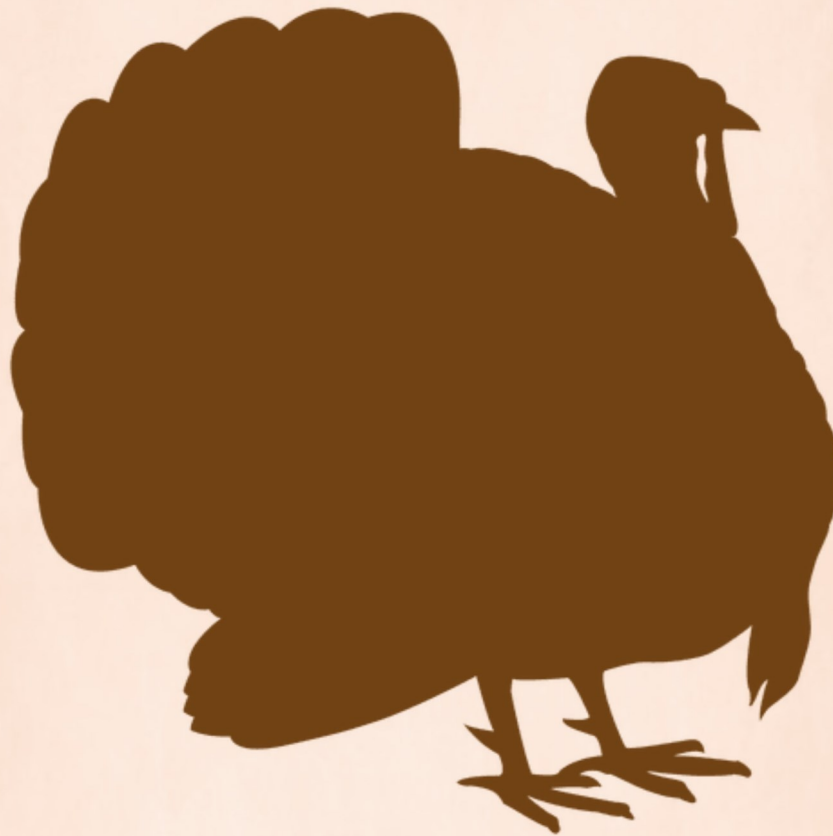
